Hello Bethany Families,

I write to you with an extra pep in my step because God is visibly working here at Bethany Christian School. It seems fitting to acknowledge the gratitude that fills my heart as we head into the month of November. Paul states in Philippians 4:8, "Finally, brothers and sisters, whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things." I can't help but think about how BCS is quite literally "thinking on" and living out this verse. I hope that the following encourages you the way it has for me.

"Thinking about such things: true, noble, right"- If you were to walk into Bethany classrooms, you would witness our teachers' devotion to revealing who God is and the role He plays in our life. Ms. Dewitt's fifth grade class finished studying Deborah from the book of Judges. She highlighted how God used Deborah to remind Israel to be courageous because He is with them. In Ms. Wooster's fourth grade class, students learned the difference between a hedonistic worldview and a Christ-centered worldview (serving ourselves versus serving Jesus). As I was shepherding a Student Council meeting not long ago, one of the council members was praying for peace over a situation, and calling on God to empower the Student Council team to help lead the elementary school diligently. I had the blessing of witnessing firsthand the Holy Spirit at work in our Bethany students as they apply these class discussions to their lives. In Library this past week, Mrs. Wagner taught on God's righteousness through her lessons on Reformation Day. Parent volunteers from library class sent emails to the administration sharing how even they were moved by the lesson of God's grace through Martin Luther. It is a true inspiration to see God using all ages as His vessels.

"Thinking about such things: pure, lovely, admirable"- God is using you by lending your gifts to bless our school and our community through our Bethany Parent Support Club that was launched a couple of weeks ago. We are humbled by your generosity and willingness to help us make this school the best it can be. We look forward to seeing you at our next meeting on Tuesday, November 15th. Ms. Spang has been leading students enthusiastically to raise money for our adopted Buyamba child, Jacob. Our goal is to raise \$1,000 by the end of the school year. Praise God for providing ways for us to have already raised \$700 through Wednesday chapel donations, cupcake sales spearheaded by the Middle School Exploratory Cooking class, and Back to School Night. "Thinking about such things: excellent or praiseworthy"- Lastly, I want to share with you that the school administration team has been praying for our Bethany families to come together this year more than they ever have. 
K-3 &4-6 Musicals are Thursday, Dec. 15 in the evening! (Exact times coming soon!)


